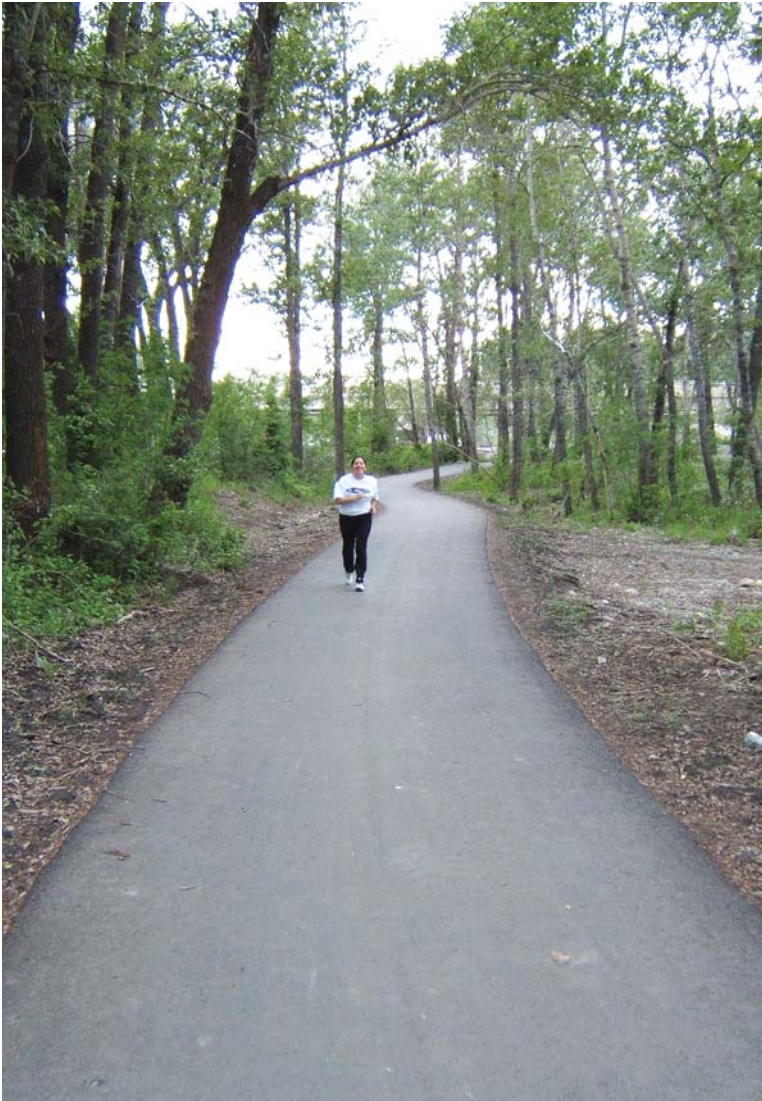


## Okotoks
