

BYLAW 44-98

**A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF OKOTOKS
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO AMEND BYLAW 33-98
FOR THE PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF PESTICIDE USE
OR KNOWN AS THE 'RIGHT TO KNOW BYLAW'**

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of Okotoks deems it desirable to amend Bylaw 33-98;

1. Section 2 - Definitions be amended as follows:

2.1 "Notification Sign" means a sign, not less than 550 cm² in area with lettering not less than 0.5 cm in height, which clearly presents the following information:"

2. This bylaw comes into force upon third and final reading.
