Study Background and Methodology


In 2018, the Town of Okotoks contracted Banister Research Limited to conduct a community survey with residents and stakeholders, continuing the research conducted in 2013 and 2009.

- The survey was promoted in conjunction with the census enumerations. The survey was available online for completion via web, with hard copies available upon request.
- A total of n=4,267 responses were collected from May 1st to June 15th 2018.
- Where possible, the results of this survey are compared to the results of the 2013 and 2009 surveys.
 - Due to the opt-in or self-select nature of the survey, results cannot be assigned a margin of error.

Quality of Life

What makes Okotoks a **good place** to live? (Top Responses)*

- Small town atmosphere e.g., friendly people, family orientated, lifestyle (38%)
- Parks, green spaces, river valley, pathways (32%)
- Amenities, services, and facilities (26%)
- Availability and convenience of shops and restaurants; friendly service (25%)
- Location e.g., near big city, mountains and countryside (22%)


What would make Okotoks a **better place** to live? (Top Responses)*

- Reduce taxes, including business and property taxes (18%)
- Restrict development; keep the Town small; stop big box stores; slow down growth, overall (17%)
- Water is too expensive; ensure water supply, better quality water, and fewer watering restrictions (17%)
- More shopping and restaurants, including longer hours, friendlier service; a shopping mall (16%)
- Better snow removal, sanding, and street cleaning (including pathways) (12%)

Has your quality of life improved or declined in the last 3 years?*




Overall, how would you rate safety in the community?

What safety and crime issues are the greatest concern for you?* **





How likely are you to make changes that would lessen your environmental footprint?




Considering the interactions you have had over the past year with Town employees, please rate your level of satisfaction in the following areas:


When you think about Okotoks Town Council, how satisfied are you with each of the following areas?





Overall Satisfaction with Town Services


How satisfied are you with the services provided by the Town of Okotoks?


Thinking back over the past 12 months, do you feel the quality of service provided by the Town has...?

Has the quality of each service increased, decreased or stayed the same over the past 3 years?*



What is your level of satisfaction with each service?*



Importance versus Satisfaction





Increase in Snow Clearing Service


To facilitate an increase in snow clearing in residential areas, how much would be willing to pay on your taxes?





Value for Tax Dollar


How would you rate the value for your tax dollars that you receive from the Town?

Town's Priority


Obtaining a long-term water supply is currently the Town's top priority. If there is a budget remaining, what do you think the <u>next most important</u> priority should be? (Top Responses)*

- Improve snow removal services (7%)
- Restrict development, slow down Town growth, and/or keep a population cap (6%)
- Improve police and law enforcement services; reduce the crime rate (6%)
- Add more recreational facilities, programs, and activities (5%)
- Improve road maintenance i.e., repairs and upgrades (5%)
- Don't know / not stated (43%)


How satisfied are you with the quality of communication/notification that you receive from the Town?

What methods do you use as your major source(s) of information regarding the Town?*






