

# Q1 Would you participate in a scheduled deer count using a free app while walking around parks, natural areas, etc.?





# Q2 Would you prefer to report deer throughout the year rather than only during a scheduled annual deer count?





# Q3 How often would you report deer (and other wildlife/plants) sightings using an app?





## Q4 Do you have a problem with deer damaging your yard and/or garden?









## Q8 What do you think is the main feeding attractant for deer in Okotoks?






