**Title:** Acquisition of Land for Municipal Purposes

**Policy Statement:**

The Mayor and municipal commissioner are authorized to enter into right of first refusal agreements for the acquisition of property that may be required for future municipal purposes.

That the Mayor and Municipal Commissioner be authorized to enter into option to purchase or offer to purchase agreements for securing easements, right-of-way, or lands for municipal projects where such projects are contained in an approved budget or have been previously authorize by Council.

**Purpose:**

1. Allow the Town to react quickly to situations where land is to be sold and may be required for future municipal purposes by granting the Mayor and Municipal Commissioner authority to enter into right of first refusal agreements.
2. Allow designated officials to expeditiously enter into agreements for land transactions depending on the circumstances and urgency of the situation.
