

IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must be one of the following, as required by Section 53 of the Local Authorities Election Act:

- a) one piece of photo identification with name and current address issued by a Canadian government (federal, provincial, local, or an agency thereof) e.g.: Alberta Operator's (Driver's) License or government issued identification card;
- or*
- b) one piece of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer under the Election Act that establishes name and current address, as listed below:
 - Attestation of residence issued by the authorized representative (landlord) of a commercial property management company
 - Attestation of identity and residence issued by the authorized representative of a correctional institution
 - Attestation of residence issued by the authorized representative of a First Nations band or reserve
 - Attestation of residence issued by the authorized representative of a post-secondary institution
 - Attestation of identity and residence issued by the authorized representative of a shelter or soup kitchen
 - Attestation of identity and residence issued by the authorized representative of a supportive living facility or treatment center
 - Bank/credit card statement or personal cheque
 - Correspondence issued by a school, college or university
 - Government cheque or cheque stub
 - Income/property tax assessment notice
 - Insurance policy or coverage card
 - Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee
 - Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation
 - Residential lease or mortgage statement
 - Statement of government benefits: e.g.: employment insurance, old-age security, social assistance, disability support, or child tax benefit
 - Utility bill: e.g.: telephone, public utilities commission, television, hydro, gas or water
 - Vehicle ownership, registration or insurance certificate
