


WE REMEMBER





Florence War Cemetery, Italy

Dave Armstrong, son of Ray Armstrong who lived north of Okotoks, served as private in the Royal Canadian Army.

David was killed in action in 1944 during the Italian campaign. Florence, which was taken by the Allied forces on August 13, 1944, was the centre of the Arno line and the point from which the attack on the German Gothic Line defences in the Apennines was launched.

Most of those buried here lost their lives in the fighting in this area from July to September 1944.
