Frank Carr was born and raised on the family farm west of Okotoks. He was the son of Herb and Henrietta Carr. Frank joined the air force in 1941 and received his pilot's wings at Macleod. After two weeks in England, he was transferred to Egypt for training. In early 1943, Frank's parents received a letter from RCAF Casualties Officer Milton Foss: "The Blenheim Aircraft of which your son was pilot crashed 150 yards south of Nakuru, Kenya Colony." Frank was 27. He is buried at the Nakuru North Cemetery in Kenya.
