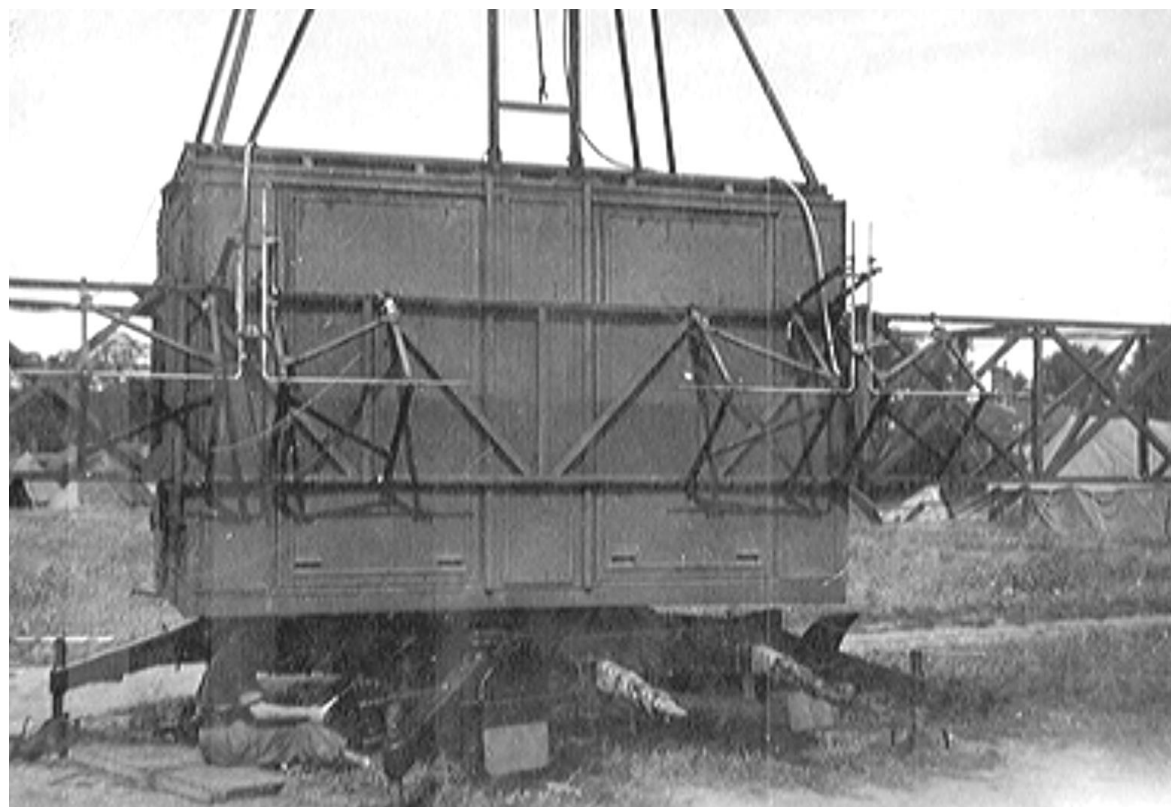
Harvey Gordanier

**Sergeant

**Killed in Action
March 13, 1945
Age 30**



Harvey was born in Edmonton and, following the deaths of his parents, he and two siblings came to Okotoks to be raised by the W. H. Jenkins family. Harvey served with the 1st Radar Battery of Royal Canadian Artillery. This was a small unit whose role was to detect enemy mortar fire. Sgt. Gordanier was wounded March 10, 1945 when he and his troop commander's Jeep ran over a mine while on recce in the area of Veen, clearing the way to the Rhine.

He died of his injuries on March 13, 1945 at the age of 30. Harvey is buried in the Groesbeek Canadian War Cemetery in Gelderland, Netherlands.
