Ronald was born on the family farm, immediately north of Okotoks, one of seven children. He was one of the first to sign up from the Okotoks district. He joined the air force in 1939 and trained as a wireless operator/air gunner. Ron was one of three McIntyre brothers to enlist, but only one, Malcolm, came back.

His last letter home arrived Oct. 13, 1941. He wrote: *"I'd be content to settle on the farm now, but not until this job is done."* Two days later, on Oct. 15, Ron's plane failed to return. It was established months later that it had been shot down over Dusseldorf, Germany. He was 24. Ron is buried at Durnbach War Cemetery at Bad Tolz, Bayern, Germany.
