Arnold was born in B.C. but raised and educated in Okotoks. He enlisted in 1939 and graduated from SFTS, Uplands Field, Ottawa in 1941, and attended officer's and instructor's training at Trenton. Arnold served on west coast patrol duty and as an instructor before being sent to the Aleutians where he received the U.S. Air Medal.

Arnold went overseas in January 1944. He took part in D-Day operations and his overseas tour was almost complete when he was reported missing July 13, 1944.

He was 28. He is buried at the Bretteville-Sur Laize Canadian War Cemetery at Calvados, France.

Most of those buried there died during the later stages of the battle of Normandy.
