James Prosser Rowles was born and raised in Okotoks, the youngest son of Kansas and Annie Rowles who were pioneers of the area. He achieved the title of lance corporal with the Royal Canadian Armoured Corps. He was fatally injured on Friday, May 25, 1945 when the tank he was in rolled down an embankment, throwing him from the tank and rolling on top of him. He was 31. James Prosser Rowles is buried at the Groesbeek Canadian War Cemetery in Gelderland, Netherlands. He was married with two small children.
