


Rich's Playground Upgrade What We Heard Report

The first phase of public participation for the Rich's Playground Upgrade project took place in May 2021 through an online survey. The results of that survey indicated support for having nature based elements added to the existing standard play equipment. Town residents were invited to provide input on the last phase of the Rich's Playground Upgrade project through an online survey, where they were asked to select from three design concepts, that launched on February 1 and closed on February 15.

Administration would like to thank everyone who participated. Community engagement and involvement is a priority for the Town and the survey responses have helped us determined the next steps of the Rich's Playground Upgrade project.

Public Participation – What Stage?

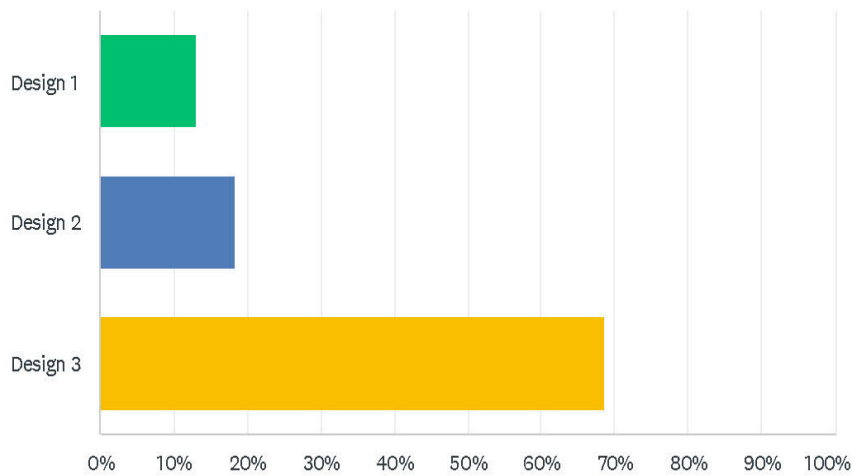
The Rich's Playground Upgrade engagement was at the **Consult** level.

This report contains the survey results summary and responses; a total of 382 people provided their preference for the design of the upgrade. The results of the survey have indicated that, out of the three design options provided, design 3 received the most support. Of the 382 respondents, 68.59% selected option 3; 18.32% selected option2 and 13.09% selected option 1.
