General Information

The Okotoks cemetery is located at **30 Westland Street**, on the corner of Big Rock Trail and Westland Street. The main entrance off Westland Street. A locked gate at the entrance from Big Rock Trail is opened during interment services.

Buying the right interment space (burial plot, columbarium niche, or scattering cremains) is important if you want to make sure there is a convenient resting place for loved ones and family members to pay tribute to and visit the deceased. There are a number of options when it comes to the type of interment space when planning the interment of a casket or an urn. We can help you choose an interment space whether this is a pre-need decision (to prepare in advance) or an at-need (immediate need).

Note: Human remains and cremains are permitted to be interred (placed) in the Okotoks cemetery (no pets). The Town does not sell caskets, vaults, urns, or memorial markers.



Cemetery Layout




4' x 8' Size Plot

Note: one headstone can be installed at head of plot and one footmarker can be installed at foot of plot.


2 caskets and up to 8 urns



1 casket and up to 8 urns





No casket, but up to 8 urns



4' x 4' Size In-Ground Plot


Note: included with concrete ribbon to install upright marker or without concrete ribbon for flat marker to be installed in center of plot





2' x 2' Size In-Ground Plot




Columbaria Options

Note: All niches in one columbarium unit are completely sold out before the Town starts selling in the next columbarium unit.


Large 64 niche unit: 32 niches on both sides – east and west facing. Each columbarium has a name engraved at the end of the unit: Lilac, Ash, Spruce, Elm, Maple or Oak. Each niche is 12" High, 12" wide and 16" deep. The niche is big enough to hold 2 standard size urns. There are 3 different prices: top row is most expensive and bottom row is least expensive.



Estate Unit: with 12 niches; 6 niches on each side – facing north and south. Units are #50 and #51. Each niche is 12" High, 12" wide and 12" deep. The niche is big enough to hold 2 standard size urns.



Pedestal Unit: with 8 niches; 4 niches on each side – facing north and south. Each niche is 12" High, 12" wide and 12" deep. The niche is big enough to hold 2 standard size urns.




Big Rock Scattering Garden

General Information

This garden is divided into 4 quadrants; A, B, C, D. The Town is currently selling and scattering in quadrant A. When A is filled, we will move to B, then C, then D. There will be approximately 25 scattering in each quadrant.

- Scattering is permitted annually from May 1 to October 31.
- There are no pre-need sales for scattering spaces in this garden.
- Only human cremains are permitted to be interred in the Okotoks cemetery (no pets)
- A Burial Permit and/or a Cremation Certificate must be provided to the Town Cemetery Administrator prior to scattering of cremains. This document can be obtained from the Funeral Home or Crematorium that handled the arrangements.
- In memory of your loved one, a plaque can be purchased from the Town and installed on the memorial wall beside the Big Rock Scattering Garden.
- All plantings in the garden are planted and maintained by the Town. Cremated remains
 cannot be scattered on flowers, plants or on any other site at the cemetery. Cremated ash is
 harmful to plant life. The high pH of cremated ash does not allow for the beneficial nutrients
 within to become available for plant life. In addition, the excessively high sodium (salt)
 content of cremated ash can damage the plant.





Scattering Procedures

The following procedures help the Town maintain a high level of aesthetics in our scattering garden.

- Town cemetery maintenance staff will rake back mulch in the quadrant that is currently being used and dig a small hole for the placement of cremains.
- A small flag or marker will be placed on the opening so family members or funerals homes can find the scattering location.
- Family members or Funeral Home will place/pour the cremains in the opening.
- Family members can rake soil back over the cremains.
- Cemetery staff will check that soil is raked back over the remains and will rake mulch back over the soil.
- After 72 hours, Town staff will remove any fresh flowers or mementos placed in the scattering garden by family or friends. The Town reserves the right to remove inappropriate materials of any kind at any time.
- The Town will keep the scattering garden weed free. The soil will be turned and mixed as needed.

Interment Guidelines

- An interment is permitted when the burial plot or columbarium niche owner (legal rights owner or his/her legal representative, executor or next of kin) completes an application (Sales and Service form), shows proof of plot or niche paid in full, provides a burial permit, a cremation certificate or other documents that may be required by the Town or Province of Alberta at least 2 business days' prior to the date of interment.
- All casket interments must be arranged by a Funeral Home. The Town does not have lowering devices. Funeral Homes must contact the cemetery administrator with regards to interments.
- Cemetery maintenance crew will not start closing the burial plot or columbarium niche until all family members leave the burial site. Family members may return after the closing is completed.
- Interments maybe permitted on weekends, late week days, statutory or declared holidays, subject to payment of applicable fees.
- A caretaker will be at the cemetery from the time a procession enters until it leaves the cemetery.
- An invoice will be sent to the purchaser (burial rights owner) after the interment takes place and then the purchaser will have 30 days to pay in full.

Columbarium Niche Interments

The large 64-niche units, Estate units and Pedestal units can hold up to 2 standard size urns in each niche. Large unit niches are 11" H x 11" W x 15.5" deep, smaller unit niches are 11" x 11" x 11". Granite doors are engraved by Sunset Memorial & Stone Ltd. in Calgary. Customers/owners of these columbarium niches must contact Sunset directly to order and pay for the engraving (403-243-3393). The Town of Okotoks will remove the door, courier it to Sunset for engraving and then re-install the engraved door at no extra cost.




Unit 200, the round unit, is the oldest columbarium unit in the cemetery and is **completely sold out**. This niche is big enough to hold up to 3 standard size urns. **Parklawn Granite & Bronze Ltd**. in High River engraves these columbarium doors.

Customers/owners of a columbarium niche in this unit must contact Parklawn directly to order and pay for the engraving (403-652-2904). The Town of Okotoks will remove the door for engraving and re-install the engraved door at no extra cost.

Disinterment

- A disinterment of remains shall not take place until a permit for disinterment is issued by the Director of Vital Statistics (https://www.alberta.ca/permit-exhume-body.aspx) and delivered to the cemetery administrator.
- No Provincial permit is required for the disinterment of an urn.
- Disinterment of a body must be attended by the funeral home requesting the service.
- The Town will be responsible for opening a burial plot for disinterment only to the top of the casket. A funeral director will be responsible for the removal of human remains.
- Disinterment of caskets in the lower level of a double depth burial plot will be charged double the regular disinterment fees as well as the cost of supplying grave shoring.

Memorialization without Interment

River of Memories Wall in Legacy Garden





Plaques are installed on this wall for those cremains or remains that are placed elsewhere in the world, but remembered here in a cemetery setting and include a perpetual cemetery record. The plaque is created with the deceased name, date of birth and date of death and installed by the Town. The Town assumes no responsibility for damages or loss due to vandalism. No flowers or other items are permitted to be attached to the memorial walls. All items will be removed without notice.

Purchasing an Interment Space

Burial Plot, Columbarium Niche or Scattering Cremains

- After a plot or niche is chosen and the Sales and Service form is completed, an invoice will be sent to the purchaser. The purchaser must make payment in-full within 30 days.
- Payment can be made at the Municipal Center at #5 Elizabeth Street with any form of payment (debit, credit, cash, cheque) or at the Cemetery Office at 1118 North Railway Street by cheque or cash only.
- After payment is made, the plot/niche owner will receive a Burial Deed (Certificate of Exclusive Right of Burial). This document confirms payment and shows the interment space location number (Area __, Section ___, Row ___ Plot ___).
- This document must be kept in a safe space and presented at the time of interment.



Resale of Burial Plot or Columbarium Niche

The purchaser/owner cannot sell his/her interment space on the open market. If there are no urn interments and no engravings on the door, the owner can sell the niche back to the Town of Okotoks at 85% of current day price. A letter must be sent to the cemetery administrator requesting to sell their plot/niche back to the Town and stating the plot/niche owner name, the plot/niche location number, and then date and sign the letter.

Navigating the Cemetery Grounds

- The main entrance is off Westland Street.
- The cemetery is divided into ten different gardens (signage installed throughout the cemetery). See descriptions of these gardens in this document.
- Roads are all named with signage.
- A cemetery map is posted in Legacy Garden, beside the Spruce columbarium unit.
- An outdoor washroom is located along Memorial Way (east of the maintenance yard).

Cemetery Garden Descriptions

Garden of St. James



Purchased from the Roman Catholic Church in the 1960's, we are currently selling 4' x 8' size burial plots in this garden. Upright, pillow or flat markers are permitted, but there are no existing concrete ribbons to install markers on top of. Memorial markers are all facing north. Due to road proximity at the entrance, the first 10 burial plots in Section E, Rows I & J will have memorial markers installed back to back (markers will face north or south).

Garden of Eternity



This is the newest Garden in the cemetery located just south of the maintenance yard. It has 4' x 8' size burial plots. We will start selling in this garden after all plots in the Garden of St. James North are sold out.

Concrete ribbons are installed at the head of every burial plot to install memorial markers on top of (upright, pillow or flat). Memorial markers face east & west.

Heritage Garden



All burial plots in this garden are sold. This is the oldest garden in the cemetery. Memorial markers are facing east.

Due to a Town Hall fire in the early 1930's, cemetery files were burnt. There are many unknown burial plots in this garden.

Historical Monument in Heritage Garden



This large monument was donated by the Okotoks Historical Society. It commemorates the unmarked graves of those who were buried in the cemetery over 100 years ago. It is the community's way to pay homage to those who once graced the community. Field of Honour



Documentation to prove veteran status must be provided to the Town Cemetery Administrator prior to buying a burial plot in this garden. The veteran cost for a burial plot is 50% of regular cost. Interment fees and all other fees are at regular cost. For more information on Veterans see lastpostfund.ca/EN/funeral.php, Toll Free: 1 (800) 465-7113, or email info@lastpost.ca

There are 4' x 8' size burial plots in this garden. Caskets and urns can be interred. Both the veteran and his/her spouse can be interred in one burial plot. There are no existing concrete ribbons to install markers on. Memorial markers are facing east. Memorial markers must be the Last Post design (grey granite).

Sunshine Garden



There are only a few burial plots left for sale in this garden. The 4' x 8' size plots have no existing concrete ribbons to place markers on. Memorial markers are facing east.

Garden of Peace



The Garden of Peace has a flat marker section (4' x 4' and 4' x 8' size plots) and a newer section (4 x 8 plots) with concrete ribbons to install upright monuments on. The older (north rows) of are all sold out. Markers are facing east. Four rows in the south of this garden are new. We are not selling in these rows yet. Memorial markers will be installed back to back facing east and west.

Garden of Tranquility



There are 4' x 8' size burial plots in this garden. Only flat markers are permitted and they must be installed level with the ground. There are no concrete ribbons. Markers are facing east. Double depth casket interments are not permitted along the fence (rows 27, 40, 49, 73). This is due to a drainage issue.

No flower vases, hangers, or other memorabilia is permitted in this flat marker garden.

Serenity Garden North



Serenity Garden North is sold out. The 4' x 8' size burial plots have concrete ribbons to place markers. Markers are installed back to back on the ribbon facing east or west.

Serenity Garden South



We are currently selling 4' x 8' size burial plots in this garden and all rows have concrete ribbons to place markers on. Markers are installed back to back on the ribbon facing east or west.

Double depth casket interments are not permitted along the fence (row 29).

Legacy Garden



We are currently selling 2' x 2' plots, 4' x 4' plots, columbarium niches and scattering cremains in this garden. Some plots have existing concrete ribbons to install memorial markers on. Some plots permit flat markers only (installed in center of plot).

Markers face east in the 4' x 4' size plots in the north row plots A, B, C, and D. All other plots have markers facing either north or south.

Other General Information

- The general maintenance of the cemetery is done by Parks staff. In order to allow for proper mowing, maintenance and keeping the cemetery attractive, clean and consistent with other cemeteries, we ask all residents and visitors to follow the rules when it comes to items being placed on or around the burial sites. Items that become tattered, torn, sun bleached, or in disrepair will be removed as per the cemetery bylaw to keep the cemetery attractive and peaceful.
- Annually, between May and October there is a full time cemetery maintenance person at the cemetery.
- An annual cemetery cleanup is done every spring before Mother's Day. This notice is posted in the Western Wheel and on the Town website.
- Bi-annually, there is a Cemetery Open House in August or September (posted in the Western Wheel & on the Town website).

Okotoks Cemetery History

The Okotoks cemetery was established in 1889 on one acre of land and owned by St. Luke's Presbyterian Church. The Roman Catholic Church owned one acre of land west of this cemetery.

In 1914, the Town bought the cemetery from the Presbyterian Church. Then, in the 1960's the Town bought the Roman Catholic cemetery. Today, the cemetery is ~10.5 acres with over 5,000 burial plots, Columbarium units, a Scattering Garden, and Memorial Walls.

The cemetery is filled with colorful flowerbeds, mature trees, park benches, a pergola, a stone table, water stations, an outdoor washroom and various wildlife that gives the cemetery a beautiful, serene park-like setting and definitely creates a peaceful final resting place for loved ones.



The Town of Okotoks Cemetery Monument/Marker Guidelines

The Town of Okotoks does not sell monuments. The monument company you choose must contact the Town for a marker permit. There are sections of the cemetery that permit the installation of upright monuments, and other sections that permit flat (flush with the ground) markers. These are sizes permitted.

Columbarium Niche Door Engravings

- There are no permit fees for shipping a columbarium door for engraving, but a marker permit must be completed and sent to the Town cemetery administrator for cemetery records.
- Unit 200 niche doors are engraved by Parklawn Granite in High River.
- All other columbarium doors are (in all other units), are engraved by Sunset Memorial & Stone in Calgary.
- All columbarium door engravings are similar/consistent. Parklawn Granite and or Sunset Memorial will contact the Town for design approval before engraving.

Memorial Marker Notes

- The decision of installing a monument is entirely up to the family. There is no timeframe.
- Monument/ markers are permitted to be installed between May 1 and October 31 each year (except on concrete ribbons – permitted all year round).
- Monument companies deliver and install monuments/markers at the Okotoks cemetery.
- Plot/Niche owners or monument companies shall obtain a permit from the Town and provide a two business days' notice prior to the date of installation.
- All Town of Okotoks full size burial plots will accommodate only one headstone and one flat foot marker per plot.
- On cremation in-ground burial plots (2' x 2' & 4' x 4') only **one** marker permitted per plot: flat markers to be installed in the center of plot and upright markers on the concrete ribbon (4x4)
- All monuments/markers must be of granite, marble, limestone or bronze unless otherwise approved by the Town.
- No in-ground vase or photos are permitted on or around a foot marker installation as they may get broken by mowing/maintenance equipment.
- No work shall be done on any monument/marker without the permission of the Town.
- Monuments/markers are placed in the cemetery at the owner's risk. The Town assumes
 no responsibility for damages or loss due to vandalism, natural erosion or during
 maintenance
- No burial plot owner/legal representative shall allow any monument/marker to be in a state of disrepair. If left in a state of repair after being notified, the Town may remove the marker.
- After an interment (within 7 days), items affixed to the outside of the niche (except for flowers in the attached niche vase holders) or left on the ground will be removed without notice.

For the latest fees, please refer to page 16 of the Fees, Rates and Charges Bylaw 09-23.

The Okotoks Cemetery Resident Boundary Map aligns with the boundaries used by the Province of Alberta's Vital Statistics department. The purchaser of a burial plot, columbarium niche, scattering of cremains, or a memorial wall plaque shall be deemed as:

*"Resident" means; a person who is within the boundaries of the MD Foothills County, a current property owner within this service area or have lived within this service area for 10 consecutive years and currently resides elsewhere. A resident outside of Okotoks, but within the boundaries of the MD Foothills County Town boundaries, must show proof of residency (ie. utility bill)

***"Non-resident"** means any other person who resides beyond the geographical boundaries of the MD Foothills County
