WHEREAS DCD Awareness Week is a global initiative to promote understanding and awareness of Developmental Coordination Disorder; and

WHEREAS Developmental Coordination Disorder (DCD), sometimes referred to as Dyspraxia, affects 5-6% of children, approximately 1 in 20, or one child in every classroom in British Columbia; and

WHEREAS DCD remains an under-recognized neurodevelopmental condition affecting the ability to learn, plan and coordinate motor skills impacting the ability to perform the activities of daily living; and

WHEREAS DCD is a lifelong condition that impacts educational achievement, employment participation, and physical and mental health and quality of life; and

WHEREAS DCD Awareness Week is an opportunity to raise awareness of the presentations, challenges, and outcomes of the condition, while also celebrating the strength, resilience, tenacity, and achievements of those living with DCD.
