Report, Analysis and Financial Implications

Section 648.4 of the *Municipal Government Act* and the Town's Off-Site Levy (OSL) Bylaw 06-23 require that on an annual basis a municipality publicly, openly and fully disclose all off-site levy costs and payments. The 2024 off-site levies were imposed and this annual report was prepared using the methodology outlined in OSL Bylaw 06-23.
