Subject: Call to Artists to Design and Paint Garbage Receptacles for the Okotoks Recreation Centre

The Town of Okotoks is thrilled to announce an exciting opportunity for four artists to help enliven the Okotoks Recreation Centre.

We invite talented and passionate artists to submit their proposals to paint recreation themed murals on four garbage bins at the Okotoks Recreation Centre. The designs should reflect values in the Town of Okotoks <u>Vision and Mission Statements</u>. This project will help beautify the Recreation Centre for all visitors.

We encourage Alberta artists of all backgrounds, styles, and experiences to apply and share their unique artistic vision with the community.

Key Details:

- The bins will be located at the Okotoks Recreation Centre
- Paint supplied by the Town of Okotoks
- Four artists will be selected to design and paint one bin each.
- Shape: see Appendix A
- Fun and colourful murals are encouraged.

Paint dates:

- Bins will be delivered to artists' studios in March, 2024
- Project to be completed and picked up by April 30, 2024



Compensation:

• \$1250.00 per bin

Submission Requirements:

- Artist Statement: Provide a brief (one page max) artist statement of your artistic background, inspirations, and approach to creating art.
- Portfolio: Showcase a selection of past work that highlights your artistic style, versatility, and proficiency in creating visually engaging artwork. Include images or descriptions of previous mural projects, if available.
- References: Include three references or testimonials from previous clients, teachers or collaborators to provide evidence of your professionalism and quality of work
- Concept (1 page maximum): A written description explaining the relevance of your design concept for this mural.
- Vision: A visual representation (sketch, painting, collage, etc.) of your proposed design.




