Recreation Facilities: Manual labour duties related to maintaining ice, equipment and indoor facilities. Provide customer services, including handling/taking complaints, crowd control, event set-up/tear-down, assistance to user groups and basic security. Work independently & with minimal supervision. Operate vehicles & equipment in a safe and effective manner. Ensure work area and equipment are clean & general maintenance is performed. Other duties as assigned to facilitate events and emergency situations. Ad hoc projects as assigned & provide support to other business centres when required.
