PARTNERSHIPS

Partner with key 'anchor institutions'

 This could include post-secondary, senior government, healthcare, arts and cultural institutions.

Collaborate across the region

Partner with neighbouring municipalities and business organizations across the region.



BUSINESS FRIENDLY

Be flexible with commercial spaces

Spaces could include incubators, shared work spaces, and home-based businesses.

Make it easier for small businesses

- Support start ups, renovations, and growth.
- Designate a coordinator to walk people through permitting processes.



INNOVATION

Establish an Innovation or Business District

 This could support new businesses, attract progressive new industries, and promote Okotoks as a leader in innovation.

Support green business
